### DESCRIPTION

Homestay accommodation gives students the opportunity to experience the everyday life and customs of a local Spanish home. A homestay is the best option for those who want to practice their Spanish as much as possible, since students will share two daily meals with their hosts and will have plenty of opportunities to speak. This is our most popular housing option.

### QUICKFACTS

- Single or double rooms in homestays in accordance with special diets, allergies and non-smoking preferences.
- Homes located in Eixample, Ciutat Vella, Sagrada Familia, Gracia, Sants - Montjuïc, Les Corts, Sarrià - Sant Gervasi y Sant Martí, maximum commute of 35 minutes to the school.
- Shared bathroom and common areas
- Half board (breakfast and dinner) every day
- Guaranteed free Wi-Fi
- Bed linens and towels
- Weekly cleaning of bedroom and change of sheets/towels
- Access to laundry machine (students responsible for doing own laundry at home, dryers are not guaranteed)

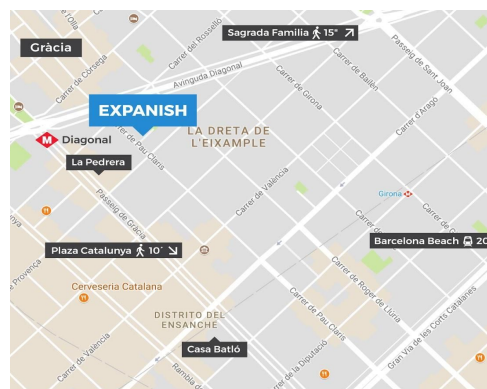

## LOCATION OF HOMESTAYS

Our homestays are located in the best and safest neighborhoods in the city and they will always be within a maximum of 35 minutes from the school. Example neighborhoods are Sagrada Familia, Gracia, Ciutat Vella, and many more. They will always be within 5 blocks of public transportation (subway or bus) that comes close to the school to make your daily commute as easy as possible.



## MATCHING STUDENTS TO A HOST

When students book a program with us we will ask if they object to living with smokers or house pets, and if they have any special needs like dietary restrictions or allergies. We can always guarantee these minds, and we will use them to assign students to a homestay. Students are more than welcome to include other special requests, like living in a specific neighborhood, and we will do our best to accommodate but cannot 100% guarantee them.

**WHO WILL STUDENTS LIVE WITH?**

Students will live with a local Spanish family, which could be a couple or a single host, with or without children. In homestays, students will have someone at home to help them adjust to Spain, share meals, and to practice Spanish. Some host more than one student at a time, which means students could live with one or more other students as well.

**CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT**

- Check-in on Sundays after 12pm (noon)
- Check-out on Saturdays before 12pm (noon)

\*Students may not arrive to their housing before 8am without booking the room from the day before. If students arrive before check-in time, they may not be able to move into their room until after 12pm.

**NOTES**

- Students must inform the school of any dietary restrictions or allergies upon booking a homestay.
- Students will receive a key to the home upon arrival.
- Housing assignments are sent out 2 weeks before arrival.
