DESCRIPTION

Spanish in the City is designed for students who want to learn Spanish while exploring the city with a private guide. Students participate in our regular Intensive Spanish 20 course for half the day and spend the other half with 6 hours of private lessons visiting museums, cafes, cultural centers and using Spanish in real situations with the support of a professor.
