



THE ULTIMATE SPANISH CRASH COURSE

DESCRIPTION

The Ultimate Spanish Crash Course is designed specifically for travellers who want to learn the basics of Spanish communication needed for everyday situations. The class will help complete beginners to survive while travelling in any Spanish-speaking country by teaching the vocabulary and phrases needed when eating at a restaurant, while shopping for souvenirs and for meeting locals.

- "¿Cuál es la cotización del dólar?"
- "Me duele la cabeza."
- "¿Cuánto cuestan esas botas de cuero?"
- "Quiero comprar dos pasajes de coche-cama a Iguazú."

MODULAR CURRICULUM

The course is divided into five individual modules of two hours each. Students can decide which modules they would like to complete, selecting just one or all five.

- Module 1: Eat, Drink and Practice Your Spanish
- Module 2: Shop til You Drop and Do It in Spanish
- Module 3: On the Move, Travel in Spanish
- Module 4: Everyday Fundamentals, Ask for It in Spanish
- Module 5: Making Friends and Socializing in Spanish

INDIVIDUALS OR CLOSED GROUPS

This course is an individual lessons for solo travellers or can be a closed group classes for those travelling together. The more people in the course, the more economical the price is per person.

FUN, FLEXIBLE AND INFORMATIVE

The crash course is designed to be fun, interactive and engaging and class time includes role playing, games and listening and speaking exercises. The classes are a great introduction to Buenos Aires as they incorporate content specific to Latin American culture and tourism.
