



# SPANISH FOR TEACHERS

## Factsheet 2019

### DESCRIPTION

Spanish for Teachers is a teacher training seminar for language teachers looking to improve their skills. The course is divided into 2 week-long modules (A and B) and students can sign up for just one module (A or B) or both (AB). The course consists of theoretical lessons and practical teaching hours where students will learn the language acquisition theory and teach real Spanish students.

### WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

This course is for Spanish teachers (native or non-native speaking) who teach Spanish as a second or foreign language and who have a minimum Spanish level of C1 (Advanced). It is for those who want to perfect their language teaching through theory and practical classroom experiences and have a chance to prepare authentic classroom materials for future use.

## Academic Program

### Module A (July 15th to 19th)

- Session 1. Levels of Spanish according to the Curriculum Plan of the Cervantes Institute.
- Session 2. Selection and adaptation of materials for the classroom
- Session 3. Introduction to some of the main grammatical problems that Spanish poses.
- Session 4. Class zero: learning to learn
- Session 5. Planning and managing the second language classroom with game dynamics

### Module B (July 22nd to 26th)

- Session 1. Culture and interculturality in the ELE classroom
- Session 2. Learning strategies in the ELE classroom
- Session 3. Activities for the exploitation of lexicon
- Session 4. Analysis of materials
- Session 5. Introduction to the teaching of Spanish for specific purposes: Business Spanish

Students will complete 10 hours of weekly practice classes always accompanied by one of our professors. Students will have the opportunity to put into practice the knowledge imparted in the theoretical sessions in a real situation.
